

Independent Study – Intl St 199

The independent-study option, available primarily to upper-division students, allows a student to create a course with an instructor. The plan for the course will include a reading list, a group of assignments, examinations, papers, or similar evidence of intellectual achievement on which academic credit will be based. A description of the course and of its requirements must be approved by the student’s faculty.

In order to organize an independent study course, you need to do the following:

- 1. Find an instructor willing to act as your faculty supervisor.
2. Fill out the Independent Study form and obtain the signature of your faculty supervisor.
3. Submit form to department office to obtain an authorization code. Code will be provided by the Department Manager, Jessica Cañas-Castaneda (jcanas@uci.edu).

Enrollment must be completed by 5pm on Friday of the second week of the quarter to meet the School of Social Sciences deadline.
